**TODAY**—And for all of March, we will use the 4<sup>th</sup> Eucharistic Prayer on p. 88 during Sunday Mass.

**PASSIONTIDE** – Passiontide continues, the last two weeks before Easter. It commemorates the solemn turn the church takes in the Lenten Season as Christ prepares for the Passion. You’ll notice the crucifixes in church are covered, that the organ is muted at times, and that “Lord for us, your wounds were suffered” replaces “Glory be to the Father...”
