EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER- Today, and for all of November, we use the 2nd Eucharistic Prayer on pg. 82.

ADULT EDUCATION – We had quite an evening of theological discussion this past Wednesday, November 6, as Fr. Jason and Sub-Deacon Jim presented to 17 total on the Sacramental Theology of the PNCC. We noted some history of each Sacrament and how many of them slightly differ from other churches. Our final class “our place in Christianity”, will be next week, on Wednesday, November 20 at 6pm.

WHAT CHANGES? – As a new Deacon, a few changes will take place during Mass. The ancient order of Deacon was to serve the bishop, and how the bishop assigns him. Deacon Jim will now proclaim the Gospel and sing the dismissal at the end of Mass. He will also be permitted to serve Holy Communion during Mass. Though it may seem he is “taking over” for what Fr. Greg often does, this actually elevates Fr. Greg’s role, as the higher honor of a clergyman is to be seated in Sanctuary. It is Fr. Jason’s purview (with the bishop’s guidance) as to how often the Deacon will preach. In Fr. Jason’s absence, priority is always to have Holy Mass celebrated, which means a call to Fr. Greg. If not available, then the Deacon would celebrate a “Service of Worship and Holy Communion”, in which familiar aspects of the Mass are present, but the Eucharist will have been consecrated prior by a priest. See any clergy for questions.

CLOTHING DRIVE – After a year hiatus, the National United YMSofR is once again holding a clothing drive across the entirety of the Polish National Catholic Church. Parishes will collect all sorts of new and previously-loved clothing and tabulate what was collected at the end of the drive. The clothing will be donated locally and the results sent in to the Central YMSofR. We begin collecting next Sunday with a bin in our Fellowship Hall – see the bulletin board for details.
