This elevation will take place at a 10am Mass. An "Acolyte" in orders is allowed to put on/out candles, serve wine and water, and can assist on the "other" side of the altar. A Sub-Deacon is the last step in Cleric Jim's journey to the Diaconate. He is then allowed to wear an alb, amice, cincture & tunic, and is in charge of cleaning the Holy Vessels (chalice, etc.).

The following Sunday, we will hold an informational meeting between Holy Masses to provide the happenings of the Synod and how St. Mary's is affected by them.
