**PASTOR AWAY** – Please note that Fr. Jason is away for the first half of this week to be with family in Massachusetts. He remains available via email and phone for any parish needs – please note changes in the weekly calendar compared to the monthly calendar sent earlier.

**CANON** –Today, we use the 2<sup>nd</sup> Eucharistic Prayer on p. 82, the Canon of St. Hippolytus. Next week, and for the month of March, we will use the 3<sup>rd</sup> Eucharistic Prayer on p. 84, the Canon of St. Basil.

**PANCAKES!** – Thank you to the parish men who provided last Sunday’s Pancake Breakfast. We certainly felt the love, even one day removed from Valentine’s Day.

**MISSION CROSS** – The Mission Team, as every Lent, has raised the prayer cross in the corner of the church near the votive candles. We encourage you to use it as an opportunity to practice the first Lenten Disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Envelopes, papers, and pencils are on the nearby sill to offer your prayer to be pinned on the cross. All prayers will remain anonymous and be offered up to our Lord at the conclusion of Lent.

**LENTEN RETREAT**– Saturday, March 7, from 10am-2pm, the Lenten Retreat of the Northeast Seniorate of the Western Diocese takes place at St. Mary’s. A sign-up sheet is near the glass entrance doors – please sign it if you plan on attending so we can plan food. This retreat is open to anyone and encouraged for all parishioners & friends. It will include 3 short presentations, two meals, and a guided Holy Hour of St. Augustine before the Most Blessed Sacrament. See Fr. Jason with any questions.

**LENT**—Friday nights will feature Lenten Devotions-please join your faithful Christians each week as we walk the Stations of the Cross and as we offer the Bitter Lamentations. The schedule & times is posted in our calendars as well as in our bulletin. We also have prayer booklets, donated by Carol S. from Michigan to guide us through the season.
