

NEW LITURGICAL CYCLE – The First Sunday in Advent brings about many changes – different vestments, a wreath, a time to collect thoughts in a penitential season. It also brings about “Liturgical New Year: Cycle A” that is, the readings are of a prophetic nature, the gospel

begins in a new point of history (preparing for the coming of Christ), and the gospel is from St. Mathew after hearing from mostly St. Luke for the past year. Any questions about this, please see Fr. Jason.

CANON –for all November, we use the 4th Eucharistic Prayer on p. 88.

EVENING BIBLE STUDY – On hiatus through year’s end. Please let Fr. Jason know your thoughts on when, how, and where we could continue this ministry in the new year.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS – Might you want to nominate someone to serve on the Parish Committee for 2026? Reach out to Fr.
