CORPUS CHRISTI–Sunday, June 23 is the Sunday within the Octave of Corpus Christi. The Church calls us to have a Eucharistic Procession, and, since we have the ability, we tentatively plan on having it outdoors like we did last year. The entire congregation will be asked to process to the four corners of the church, gathering in prayer at each.

SEMI-ANNUAL MEETING – A semi-annual meeting is scheduled for Sunday, June 23rd after the 9am Mass. There will be no second Mass this day, but a light luncheon will precede the meeting. The purpose is to review issues halfway through the year, rather than to do everything at once at the Annual Meeting. Reports from parish organizations will not be required.

MAY DEVOTIONS – Our month devoted to the Blessed Mother has concluded. We met 5 times in May, praying the Litany to the BVM, offering the Marian Antiphon, and adoring the presence of Christ in the blessed Eucharist. We did 3 services in English, 2 in Polish; 4 celebrated by Fr. Jason, 1 celebrated by Fr. Greg, 3 sermons given by Fr. Jason, and 2 given by Sub-Deacon Jim.

REMEMBER - June is Sacred Vocations month. This is the time when we must pray for and encourage young (and not so young) men to the priesthood. Start small – try to get your grandson to become an altar server. But Vocations go farther than that. Ask your daughter if she would like to be a lector, or ask your niece if she would like to be an altar server. We need more to serve our Lord!
