PARISH ANNUAL MEETING – Takes place today after 9am Mass.

PRE-LENT – Pre-Lent is an ancient Christian observance of devotion that was in preparation for the fasting and atonement of the Lenten Season. It allowed some to begin their fast even earlier. In this period,

flowers were traditionally removed from the sanctuary, as were the Gloria and the Alleluia verse. Thematically, it really is in between the “green” of Jesus’s ministry and the “violet” of penance and the buildup of the case against Christ that is the Lenten Season. The rose-colored vestments show that thematic bridge in tone and in devotion.
