Stanley Bilinski, passed away this past week, early morning on All Souls Day, November 2. Bishop was recovering from his recent heart attack and, unfortunately, his body couldn't withstand the extra stress on his heart. His soul, however, has only been empowered by the weakness of his body. May he rest in peace with his fellow Apostles in the ordained and consecrated ministry of Jesus Christ. The funeral will be held this Thursday in Chicago. Copies of his obituary have been posted on the bulletin board.

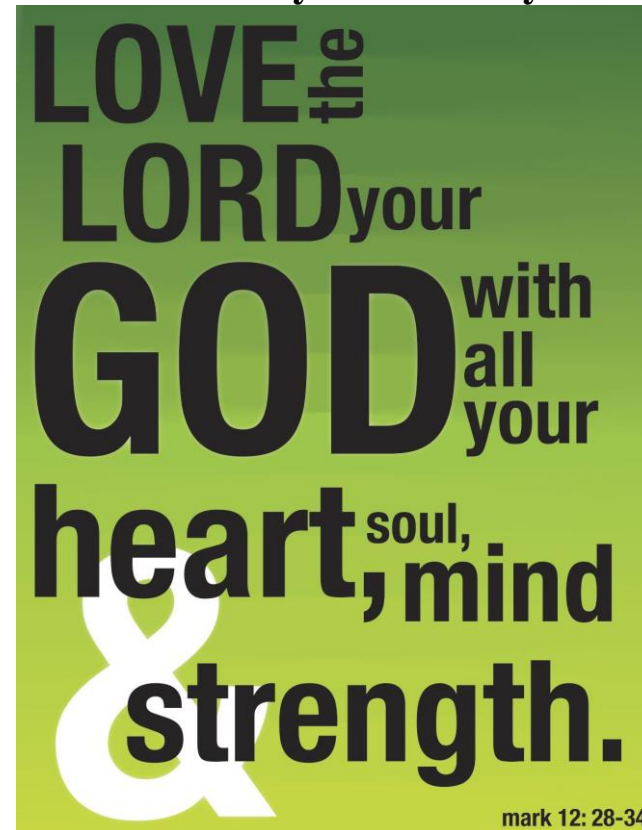
