PARISH MEETING – A parish-wide meeting takes place after 9am Mass to discuss the Oct. 25 Special Synod as well as the closing info regarding the 2019 PolishFest and opening work into 2020’s PolishFest.

ORDINATION TO DIACONATE – Prime Bishop Anthony Mikovsky has announced that Sub-Deacon James Ploskonka will be Ordained to the Major Order of Deacon on Sunday November 10, 2019. Prime Bishop will visit St. Mary’s for a 9am Mass only to impart the Sacrament of Holy Orders on Sub-Deacon Jim. A brunch will follow – see below.

RSVP – Thank you for all who RSVP’d to the Ordination Brunch. Please inform Fr. Jason or sign the sheet near the Fellowship Hall doors.

WHAT CHANGES? – Once Sub-Deacon Jim is ordained to be Deacon, a few changes will take place during Mass. The ancient order of Deacon had a few roles to assist the Bishop, and that holds true in 2019 with the priest. Deacon Jim will now always proclaim the Gospel. He will also be permitted to serve Holy Communion during Mass. He will also always sing the dismissal at the end of Mass. Though it may seem he is “taking over” for what Fr. Greg often does, this actually elevates Fr. Greg’s role, as the higher honor of a clergyman is to be seated in Sanctuary. It is Fr. Jason’s purview (with the bishop’s permission) as to how often the new Deacon will preach, but it will be closer to monthly. Finally, in Fr. Jason’s absence, the first priority is to have Holy Mass celebrated, which means a call to Fr. Greg. If not available, then the new Deacon would be able to celebrate a “Service of Worship and Holy Communion”, in which much of rite is replicated, but the Eucharist will have been consecrated in a prior Mass in preparation.
