EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER- Today, and for the entire month of February, we use the 5th Eucharistic Prayer that begins on pg. 92.

PRE-LENT – Pre-Lent is an ancient Christian observance of devotion that was in preparation for the fasting and atonement of the Lenten Season. It allowed some to begin their fast even earlier. In this period, flowers were always traditionally removed, as well as the Gloria and the Alleluia. Thematically, it really is in between the “green” of Jesus’s ministry and the “violet” of penance and the buildup of the case against Christ that is the Lenten Season. The rose-colored vestments show that thematic bridge in tone and in devotion.
