SYNOD INFO – The 25th General Synod of the PNCC has concluded. Today, we hold an informational meeting between Holy Masses to provide the happenings of the Synod.

PEACE/PRAYER – One of the sticking points of the Synod was making sure we provide our people with a peaceful place that they can also call “prayerful” before the celebration of Sunday Mass. Though fellowship is wonderful in a Christian setting, we ask that you respect the prayerfulness of all of our people as you make your way to the pew.
