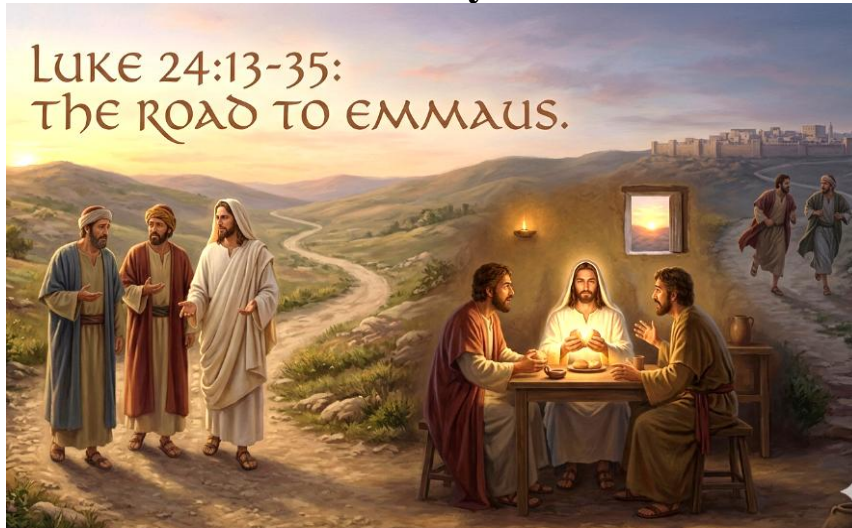

CANON –Today, and for all of April, we will use the 4th Eucharistic Prayer on p. 88.

PARISH POTLUCK – Please make note that next Sunday, April 26th, Mass will be at 10am. This is so we can have a parish potluck, a decade-plus Easter tradition here at St. Mary’s. Please consider bringing your favorite dish, be it a meat, a salad something potatoes, veggies, a dessert, an appetizer, or anything in-between.

PROPERTY CLEANUP – Each year, St. Mary’s does a bit of spring cleaning after the winter chill subsides and the green starts getting wild. On Sunday, April 26, after our 10am Mass (note time change) we will have our parish potluck followed by a clean up. This will include mulching, weeding, hedge trimming, bagging yard waste, and more. EASTER – The Easter Season begins with the Resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday and lasts 50 days, until the day of Pentecost, this year on May 24. The length of the celebration reminds us of the importance of this season and the importance of the Resurrection event in the story of our salvation. Please keep your Easter spirit strong over these next few weeks, as we remain standing throughout the Canon/Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass, as we add extra “alleluias” throughout the liturgy, and as our lilies and Easter decorations stand out in our church proper.

SKIP A NIGHT – Keep your eyes open – we will have a “Skip a Night Out” Fundraiser during the Easter Season.

POLISH PARADE – The parade for Polish Constitution Day takes place Sunday, May 3rd. St. Mary’s will be participating, perhaps in a new way. Wear a St. Mary’s Shirt! – consider joining us!
