DYNGUS DAY – or Wet Monday (Śmigus-dyngus, Lany Poniedziałek, Polewanka or Oblewanka) is the name for Easter Monday in Poland. Early morning, boys awake girls by pouring water on their heads and strike their legs with long twigs made from willow, birch or decorated tree branches (*palmy wielkanocne*). Later the focus shifted to the courting aspect of the ritual, and young unmarried girls were the only acceptable targets. A boy would sneak into the bedroom of the girl he fancied and awaken with water. Politics played an important role, and often the boy would get access to the house only by arrangement with the girl’s mother. Throughout the day, girls would find themselves the victims of drenchings and leg-whippings.
