**EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER**- Today, and for the entire month of November, we will use the 5<sup>th</sup> Eucharistic Prayer that begins on pg. 92.

**BISHOP BILINSKI** – Following our Parish Committee Meeting last Sunday, we have decided to honor Bishop Bilinski by having a parish-wide collection at Holy Mass next Sunday, November 25. At both Holy

Masses, there will be collection baskets going around again after Communion directly for the Clergy Pension Fund of the PNCC, the offering asked of Bishop’s family.
