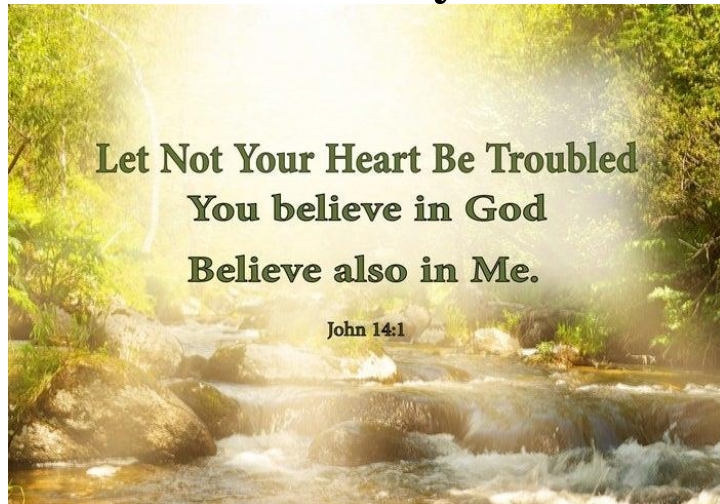

TODAY – and for the month of May, we use the 4th Prayer on pg. 88.

POLISH PARADE – The parade for Polish Constitution Day takes place today! St. Mary's will be marching in the parade. Wear a St. Mary's shirt! – please consider marching with us! The parade begins at 2pm and we ask that marchers arrive at the Parma Circle before then, just in case we head out early.

EASTER – The Easter Season begins with the Resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday and lasts 50 days, until the day of Pentecost, this year on May 28. The length of the celebration reminds us of the importance of this season and the importance of the Resurrection event in the story of our salvation. Please keep your Easter spirit strong over these next few weeks, as we remain standing throughout the Eucharistic Prayer of the Mass, add extra “alleluias” throughout the liturgy, and more.

TRUNK SALE - The annual Spring Trunk (and Bake) Sale is scheduled to take place on Saturday, May 20. This will feature a bake sale, lunch food on the grill (especially Steve’s special burgers), and many locals selling their wares. Flyers are available.
