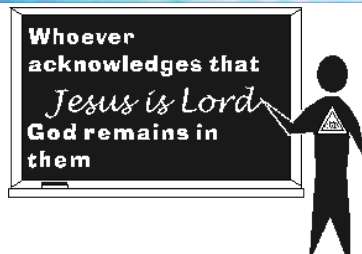

CANON/EUCHARISTIC PRAYER- Today, and for the entire month of May, we will use the 5th Eucharistic prayer on p. 92.

MAY DEVOTIONS – May Devotions to the Blessed Virgin Mary are celebrated each Wednesday in May, continuing May 12 & 26 in English and May 19 in Polish. Please consider attending these Eucharistic Devotions in honor of the Blessed Mother, patroness of our Parish. It is an opportunity to see one of the unique liturgies of the church: Litany, Exposition, a short procession, all in about 30 minutes.

EASTER – The Easter Season began with Jesus’ Resurrection on Easter Sunday and lasts 50 days until Pentecost, this year May 23. The length of the celebration reminds us of the importance of this season and the importance of the Resurrection event in the story of our salvation.
