

CANON –Today, and for all of January, we will use the 1st Eucharistic Prayer on p. 77.

CHRISTIAN UNITY – today begins the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, which began in 1908 and celebrates all of the “sames” in the Christian faith, rather than getting stuck on differences. As Fr. Jason assigned today for Penance- please pray for unity and pray for those

churches you drive by all week. The Week of Prayer begins with the Feast of St. Peter's Chair at Antioch and closes with the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul.

SCHEDULING MASSES – Fr. Jason is now scheduling Masses for 2026. You may offer a Mass for a departed loved one, for the health or in honor of someone who is living.
